New label. The project of Nina Stocker and Callie Jemmeson, who collectively have worked in the Yarra Valley, Barolo, Rhone Valley, California, Alentejo, Central Otago and elsewhere. So they should know their way around a winery. Grapes for the label – a pinot noir and this chardonnay – are mainly sourced from the Upper Yarra.

This release boasts an open-for-business fruitiness and a chalky dryness. It's an attractive combination. Pear, nectarine, spice and mineral notes. The more I tasted this the more I liked it; the more the wine's structure asserted itself over the open display of wine's fruity deliciousness. Briney, lactose notes develop with air. Ends up giving an impression of class.
