**A DRY, AUTUMNAL, FLESHY PINOT NOIR**

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New Yarra Valley producer. Beautiful packaging. Made from grapes grown in the cool Upper Yarra. Made by Nina Stocker.

It takes time to assert itself in the glass – it benefits from a quick decant, or at least some time to breathe – but it's a dry, autumnal, fleshy pinot noir with a good volume of macerated cherry-plum fruit notes. Succulent but with dry, chewy tannin through the finish. Still finding its feet but is shaping up well.
